

EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Chapter 1-XVII Scholarship Program is designed to provide annual educational scholarship grants. Each year awardees are selected by the Chapter Scholarship Committee. Candidates for the awards are evaluated by the Committee and approved by the President. Announcement of the scholarship awards will be made at the July Chapter meeting.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

APPLICANTS must be:

A Chapter I-XVII member in good standing, or

The dependent of a member, or

The immediate family of a deceased member who was in good standing at the time of death.

Including grandchildren of a member in good standing.

Accepted by, or already attending an accredited university, college or vocational institute, to include postgraduate studies.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Eligible applicants must submit their applications no later than May 31st, 2006 to the Vice-President of Chapter I-XVII of the Special Forces Association. Mail the application to the address just above ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS.

Applicants must submit the following:

A personal letter stating his/her educational and career goals and the planned use of the funds.

A current transcript, SAT/ACT score, and/or other evidence of scholastic achievement.

A letter of recommendation from his/her school counselor.

A summary of extra-curricular activities, ie volunteer work.

A letter of acceptance to an institute of higher learning.

Prior awardees may apply.
